MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve a letter of commitment, not to exceed \$2.3 Million and with financing to come after the City receives the new ladder truck. Motion passed unanimously.

5.2. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPROVE A LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR CAMERON COUNTY'S BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW GRANT PROPOSAL TO PURCHASE 47 ACRES OF LAND ON THE LAGUNA MADRE. (RICCO)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve a letter of support for Cameron County BiPartisan Infrastructure Law Grant proposal to purchase 47 acres of Land on the Laguna Madre. Motion passes unanimously.

5.3. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A BUDGET AMENDMENT FROM FORFEITURE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,712 TO PURCHASE BULLETPROOF VEST ACCESSORIES. (O'CARROLL)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve a budget amendment from Forfeiture Funds in the amount of \$6,712 to purchase bulletproof vest accessories. Motion passes unanimously.

5.4. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPROVE REVISIONS TO THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK. (DELGADO)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Medders to approve revisions to the City of South Padre Island Employee Handbook. Motion passed unanimously.

5.5. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE CONTRACTING WITH THE CAMERON COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATION FOR ELECTION SERVICES, NOT TO EXCEED \$17,000 AND EQUIPMENT NEEDED FOR THE FEBRUARY 3, 2024 SPECIAL ELECTION. (SOTO)

Council Member Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Council Member Medders to approve contracting with the Cameron County Elections Administration for Election Services, not to exceed \$17,000 and equipment needed for the February 3, 2024 Special Elections. Motion passes unanimously.
