MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND

WEDNESDAY, JULY 17, 2024

1.CALL TO ORDER

The City Council Members of the City of South Padre Island, Texas held a Special City Council Meeting on Wednesday, July 17, 2025 at the Municipal Complex Building, 2 Floor, 4601 Padre Boulevard, South Padre Island, Texas. Mayor McNulty called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A quorum was present: Mayor Patrick McNulty, Council Members Ken Medders, Joe Ricco, and Rees Langston, Lisa Graves, and Kerry Schwartz.

2.PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND TEXAS PLEDGE

Mayor McNulty led the Pledge of Allegiance and the Texas Pledge.

3.PUBLIC COMMENTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Public comments and announcements were given at this time.

4.APPROVE CONSENT AGENDA:

Council Member Langston made a motion, seconded by Council Member Medders to approve Consent Agenda Items 4.1 through 4.7. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Graves made a motion, seconded by Council Member Langston to authorize the City Manager to negotiate a contract with HDR, the highest ranked firm for services related to the Wind and Water Sports Venue. Motion passed unanimously.

5.2. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND AND THE LRGV TPDES STORMWATER TASK FORCE PARTNERSHIP, INC. FOR REPRESENTATIVE APPOINTMENT TO THE REGIONAL LOWER GRANDE VALLEY TPDES STORMWATER TASK FORCE MOA #R-RGV-TF-2024-0020. (SANCHEZ)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve a Memorandum of Agreement by and between City of South Padre Island and the LRGV TPDES Stormwater Task Force Partnership, Inc. for Representative Appointment to the Regional Lower Grande Valley TPDES Stormwater Task Force MOA #R-RGV-TF-2024-0020.

5.3. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION RELATED TO THE INFORMATION REQUESTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL REGARDING COST OF LIVING AND EMPLOYEE TURNOVER HISTORY. (GIMENEZ/DELGADO)

Director of Operations Wendi Delgado presented an update regarding cost of living, employee turnover, dates of last salary survey and market adjustment, exit interviews and cost of living history – labor statistics.

5.4. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPROVE THE 2024-25 ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE SOUTH PADRE ISLAND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. (LAPEYRE)

Council Member Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Council Member Langston to approve the 2024-25 annual budget for the South Padre Island Economic Development Corporation. Motion passed unanimously.

5.5. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A BUDGET AMENDMENT FROM THE GENERAL FUND EXCESS RESERVES IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$7,204 FOR THE COST RELATED TO THE FEBRUARY 3, 2024 SPECIAL ELECTION. (SOTO)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve a budget amendment from the General Fund Excess Reserves in an amount up to \$7,204 for the cost related to the February 3, 2024 Special Elections. Motion passed unanimously.
