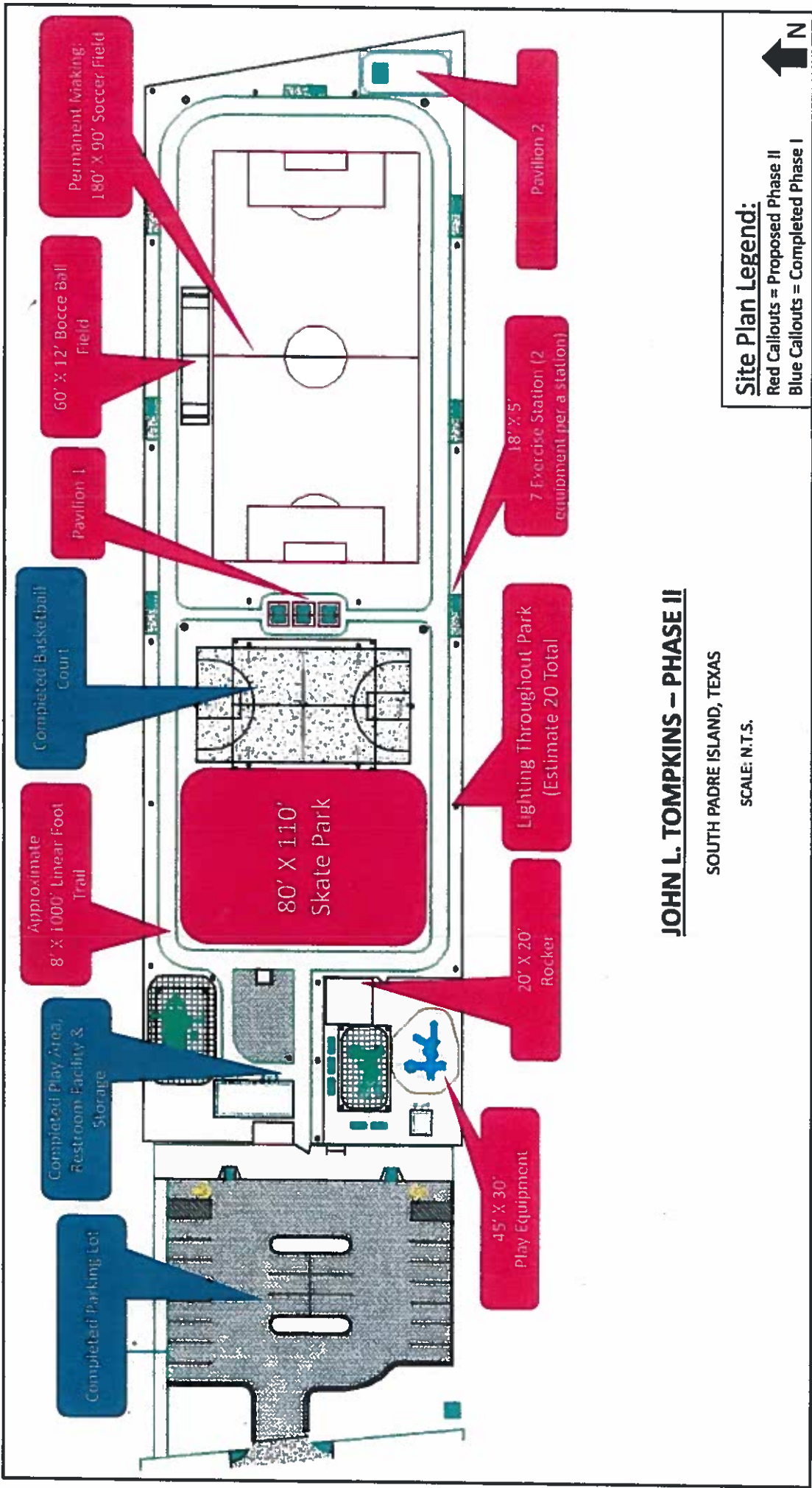












**JOHN L. TOMPKINS - PHASE II**
