Temporary daily lane closures scheduled for Queen Isabella Memorial Causeway June 3-6

Scheduled work is part of preventative maintenance to extend service life of the bridge

WHEN: June 3 through June 6, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

WHERE: Port Isabel/South Padre Island

MEDIA: TxDOT will be performing preventative maintenance to

extend the service life of the Queen Isabella Memorial Causeway. Traffic will be reduced from two lanes to one lane, only small sections at a time going eastbound or

westbound.

PORT ISABEL/SOUTH PADRE ISLAND – Drivers traveling to and from South Padre Island this coming week will encounter lane reductions while a TxDOT contractor performs preventative maintenance on the Queen Isabella Memorial Causeway.

The work will be done during non-peak hours and lane closures will be done in small sections at a time.

Road crews will be present this Monday, June 3 through Thursday, June 6, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
