# COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

City Council held a Regular Meeting on Wednesday, June 1st, covering 9-items from the Regular Agenda.

Highlights include:

- Approval of the first reading to repeal two sections in the City's Code of Ordinances.
  - Section 3-23, regarding Cats at Large, was repealed as it has not been of relevance for a significant period of time.
  - Section 12-20, regarding alcoholic beverages in the central business district, was also repealed. As development in the area has progressed, the Ordinance's original purpose is no longer applicable.
- Updates on the Wind & Water Sports Park venue:
  - The City received the green light from Council to have the current project design updated based on feedback received from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE).
  - Once the redesign is approved by the USACE, the City will be able to move forward on this longawaited project.

In the Spotlight this week is Pedro Casillas, Beach Patrol
Lieutenant (Lt.), with the City of South Padre Island Fire Department
(SPIFD)! Pedro is a valley native who grew up visiting SPI as often as he could, developing a love for the beautiful Island and its vibrant community.
Even while away for school, he was drawn back to SPI each summer.

Pedro became a Lifeguard with SPIFD in the summer of 2014, and continued to work seasonally until he graduated Texas State University in 2018 with a Bachelors degree in Exercise & Sport Science. After graduating, he stayed on

with SPIFD, continuing to advance in his career and further his education. His incredible skill, knowledge and commitment to helping others earned him a promotion to Senior Guard, then Supervisor, and now to his current position as Beach Patrol Lt. He's also certified as an EMT-B and Firefighter 1 & 2. This Summer, he'll be taking his test to become an EMT-Paramedic, the highest level of EMT certification.

Pedro has many responsibilities as Lt., but he most enjoys the opportunities to work closely with the community and assist with great events, such as the 2021 USLA National Lifeguard Championships. Coordinating and connecting with peers in his same field was a highlight of Pedro's career and a great personal achievement. USLA enjoyed their time on SPI so much, they're already scheduled to return again in 2023.
