COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Here are some highlights from June 6th City Council Budget Meeting and June 7th City Council Regular Meeting!

- Administration Coordinator Hilda Delgado presented the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for 2023-2027 and the projects rankings.
- Chief Financial Officer Rodrigo Gimenez gave an overview of the budget process and budget highlights which included General Fund revenue, property tax rate and revenue, and non-property taxes - sale taxes, mixed beverage taxes, and franchise fee. Also addressed were all other funds Hotel/Motel Occupancy excludina Tax and Convention Centre funds.



- Presentation regarding the Shoreline Department's plan and maintenance practices for raking the beach due to an expected influx of sargassum seaweed on South Padre Island's beaches this summer.
- Update regarding Laguna Boulevard.
- Discussion of the landscaping plan for the Laguna Boulevard reconstruction project.
